The **ICESKATERA OPEN 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026 and the relevant ISU Communications, PFSA Internal Rules for lower categories.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

(Twizzle must have at least 2 full revs.) If first bullet is missing – No Value will be given If one of above bullets is missing – „V“ mark will be given. If two or more of above bullets are missing – No Value will be given. Level features - Change of edge in spiral or difficult spiral position, 3 sec in position before and after the change, clear clear edges must be kept before and after the change, knee and free foot must by all the time above hip level, - More than 3 sec in difficult spiral position on curve, - Minimum five (5) clean performed steps and/or turns - Two combinations of 3 difficult turns on different feet executed with continuous flow within the sequence. Only one difficult turn may be repeated in the two combinations. Only the first combination attempted on each foot can be counted,
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- Rotations in either direction (left and right) with full body rotation covering at least 1/3 of the pattern in total for each rotational direction in Clearly visible step sequence

Split position (more than 130 deg.), Biellmann, caught spiral position with free foot above head, spiral position (at least 120 deg.), positions, which requires more physical strength or flexibility

Extra Features - Execution of 5 revolutions in basic positions (no variation) of: upright, sit or camel spin counts as a feature only once in program. - Three (3) basic positions on one foot in spin combination with or without change of foot will be counted as a feature only once in the program. III Choreo Step Sequence (ChStSq) (max. 1) There must be a maximum one (1) Choreo Step Sequence utilizing 2/3 of ice surface, which must: - consist of one (1) spiral position (with knee and foot above the hip level), kept for minimum 3sec. - Two (2) skating movement (not spiral position), (Mondo, Ina Bauer, steps, turns etc.) Level features (1 feature for lvl 1) - More than 3 sec in difficult spiral position on curve - Minimum two (2) clean performed steps and/or turns - Change of edge in spiral or difficult spiral position, 3 sec in position before and after the change, clear edges must be kept before and after the change, knee and free foot must be all the time above the hip level.
